



Domain Name registrations drop by 1.7 Million in Q1, 2002 Verisign sheds 3 million domains between January and April 2002.

Oakland, CA - April 24, 2002

Zooknic (www.zooknic.com) announced that registrations for com/net/org domains fell by 1.7 million during the first four months of 2002. From a high of 29.3 million at the beginning of the year to less than 27.6 million register domains as of April 21st.

Particularly hard hit by the continued contraction of the domain name market is VeriSign, Inc. (Nasdaq:VRSN) whose share of domain name registrations shrank by 3 million in the first 16 weeks of 2002 to 10.3 million domains.
